Magpie Bridge to Grenofen Bridge

 **Allow: 1 hr to complete this riverside walk**

 An easy short walk down stream on uneven surfaces. Stout footwear is essential as sections of the path are crossed with tree roots. **There are toilets situated in the car park at the start of the walk with a seasonal ice cream van. The walk offers numerous swimming places for dogs and humans!**

- Your starting point is the Magpie Bridge free carpark on the A386 near Horrabridge PL20 7RZ
- Take the time to explore the bridge with a popular picnic and family-friendly swimming spot
- Exit the car park to cross a grassy area to pick up a narrow unmarked riverside path
- You will often see beautiful heritage Dartmoor ponies grazing in this area
- Please do not feed or pet the ponies, as they may kick or bite no matter how adorable they are!
- Keep the river to your right, keeping an eye out for swim spots
- You will be surprised to find yourself at the base of Gem Bridge. A beautiful modern bridge, a dramatic part of Drakes Cycle Trail
- Further ahead you will reach the older Grenofen Bridge and car park
- Lean over the rails and spot trout in the sparkling water
- You can now simply return using the same path
